Participants must read and agree to abide by the following rules:

- No participant is allowed to attend the event without a signed consent form and emergency contact information.
- It is expected that all participants will participate in the program and activities. Adequate free time will be scheduled for socializing. USE OF CELL PHONES & ELECTRONIC DEVICES MAY BE RESTRICTED BY ADULT LEADERS DURING THE EVENT. Participants are welcome to leave cell phones and electronic devices at home.
- Participants will be considerate and respectful of other participants and library staff. Participants must respect others' physical boundaries. Inappropriate behavior (i.e. physical intimacy or sexual harassment) is not permitted.
- Participants will be respectful of library buildings and materials. Program activities will be scheduled to allow time for clean up. All participants are expected to assist in cleaning up food, debris, supplies, and other items used during the course of the program or activity, regardless if they personally used the items or not.
